For most of his professional life, David Van Sleet worked for the Department of Veterans Affairs, fabricating and managing prosthetics for those who had "curveballs" thrown at them. They served our country, only to suffer serious debilitating injuries while protecting us.

Two thoughts came to mind when Van Sleet worked with these injured military servicemen – they were athletic and they needed an outlet when they returned home.

'Curveballs' tells the inspirational true story of the world's first competitive baseball team made up of amputees.

Players on the Louisville Slugger Warriors National Amputee Baseball Team have been dealt curveballs. However, their bond and their brotherhood combined with their tenacity have helped them beat ablebodied foes and win tournaments.

They enjoy nothing more than toppling opponents who underestimate them. As US Army Veteran and below-knee amputee player Carlo Adame said: "This team means a lot more than just playing baseball. We get a chance to defeat the odds, which are definitely stacked against us, and adapt and overcome. I get a chance to play a sport with brothers who have fought a lot of the same battles. We are not just a team we are a family."

The Head Coach, Curtis Pride is a former Major League Baseball player who knows about overcoming adversity, he's been deaf since birth. Former MLB Pitcher and now team pitching coach Len Whitehouse has a shoulder replacement prosthesis.

Whether born without a limb as youths, or military mevmbers who returned home requiring a prosthetic device, one thing is certain, these guys have inspired others to persevere!

You'll laugh and shed a tear while hearing from these players. You'll also want to see them play and cheer them on. And no matter what curveballs life may have in store for you, you'll see how attitude, perseverance, and action can make a difference in everyone's lives.

In 1998, Mr. Van Sleet was nominated and selected as the VA National Prosthetic Chief of the Year. In 2011, David was awarded the Department of Veterans Affairs top award, the Olin E. Teague Award for Outstanding Achievement in the Rehabilitation of War Injured Veterans. In 2013, Mr. Van Sleet received The George Washington Medallion of Merit Award by the Military Order of the Purple Heart for exceptional, selfless and patriotic support to the United States military servicemen and women.

Since retirement from the Department of Veterans Affairs, Mr. Van Sleet has founded and managed the nationally known Louisville Slugger Warriors, an extremely competitive amputee baseball team. David is an honorably discharged US Veteran who resides in Estero, FL
